



## Restrictions on Transactions in Various Barclays ETN Options on Cboe Options Exchange

### Overview

Effective after the close of trading on April 12, 2018, Barclays Bank PLC delisted certain existing commodity ETNs from the NYSE Arca exchange. The Existing ETNs will no longer be listed for trading on any national securities exchange. After the delisting of the Existing ETNs from the NYSE Arca, trading in the overlying option classes will only occur if a market develops in an over-the-counter market for the Existing ETNs. Therefore, trading in the Existing ETNs options will be subject to restrictions pursuant to Cboe Options Rule 5.4. In addition, transactions in contravention of this restriction may be subject to nullification pursuant to Cboe Options Rule 6.25.

There are no restrictions in place with respect to the exercise of the Existing ETNs options.
