APPLICATION FOR MARKET MAKER HARDWIRE PILOT PROGRAM

The Equity Floor Procedure and Facilities Committees have approved a **pilot program** that will provide the installation of data lines to individual market maker terminals. The pilot program has been approved for post 2 station 1, post 5 station 8, post 5 stations 9 & 10 and a section of the OEX pit. At the present time it is intended that the necessary facility changes will be made to have the pilot program up and running by March 1, 2000. During this time staff, along with a sub-committee of the Facilities Committee, will be addressing various issues associated with hardwiring terminals in the trading pits.

The intent of the pilot program is to determine the practicality of hardwiring individual market maker handheld terminals within a trading pit and to determine what benefits it offers the user.

In order to do so we will need to know who is interested in participating in the pilot in the designated post locations. If you are interested please complete this form and return it to the 4th floor receptionist by Monday, January 31, 2000. In addition, attached is a map of your trading pit. Please indicate the area in which you are located so that staff has an idea as to where to position outlets.
