

## **CBOE Regulatory Circular RG15-082**

To: CBOE Trading Permit Holders and Vendors

RE: New PM-settled End-of-Month Option Expirations for Mini-S&P 500 Index Options (XSP)

Beginning in June 2015, Chicago Board Options Exchange, Incorporated (CBOE) will list XSP End-of-Month (EOM) expirations as part of the XSP option class. These expirations will trade under the XSP option symbol, expire on the last trading day of the applicable month and be PM-settled. On May 28, 2015, CBOE will issue a notice identifying the new strikes for the below XSP EOM expirations that will first be listed for trading on June 1, 2015.

August 2015
September 2015
October 2015
November 2015
