RE: Mandatory Use of Firm Gateway for Certain Regulatory Filings Effective July 1, 2015

eFOCUS Information Sessions, Webinar and Online Tutorials

#### This Circular updates CBOE Regulatory Circular RG15-026/C2 Regulatory Circular RG15-007

As previously announced, CBOE and C2 (collectively the "Exchanges") signed an agreement with FINRA under which FINRA began performing certain regulatory services on behalf of the Exchanges beginning January 1, 2015. In connection with the regulatory services program, and as also previously announced, the submission of various regulatory filings by CBOE and C2 Trading Permit Holders ("TPHs") will transition to the electronic filing platform available via FINRA's Firm Gateway. FINRA's Firm Gateway (<a href="https://firms.finra.org">https://firms.finra.org</a>) is a portal that provides consolidated access to various FINRA regulatory systems.

The purpose of this circular is to announce that CBOE and C2 will begin requiring certain filings to be submitted via the Firm Gateway effective <u>July 1, 2015</u>. To assist TPHs in getting acquainted with the Firm Gateway eFOCUS filing system, information sessions will be held on June 2 and 4 in the CBOE Boardroom. An eFOCUS Webinar and other online tutorials are also available online. Additional details are set out below.

#### FOCUS and Certain Financial and Other Filings – July 1, 2015

As mentioned above, the submission of various regulatory filings by CBOE and C2 TPHs will transition to the electronic filing platform available via FINRA's Firm Gateway.

In particular, effective <u>July 1st</u>, TPHs for whom CBOE is the Designated Examining Authority ("DEA") must begin submitting their FOCUS Reports and related amendments via the eFOCUS system, which is available via FINRA's Firm Gateway. Please note this is a "hard" cutover date and TPHs should continue to use the existing WinJammer or hardcopy methods of filing through June 30, 2015. After that date, the WinJammer or hardcopy methods of filing will no longer be permitted. (Please note CBOE/C2 TPHs that are also CBOE Futures Exchange, LLC ("CFE") TPHs remain subject to certain WinJammer filing requirements. See CFE Regulatory Circular RG15-021 for additional information on those CFE filing requirements.<sup>2</sup>)

<sup>1</sup> Under the existing filing methods that remain applicable through June 30th for TPHs for whom CBOE is the DEA, (i) TPHs that are net capital computing must file electronically monthly and quarterly FOCUS Reports via the WinJammer system, and (ii) TPHs that file an annual FOCUS Report and are not net capital computing must file annual FOCUS Report and Schedule 1 by sending a hard copy to the Exchange or filing electronically via the WinJammer system. (See former CBOE Rule 15.5.02 and .03 and C2 Chapter 15.)

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>2</sup> TPHs that are also FINRA members and are currently required to file FOCUS Reports with FINRA via eFOCUS, must continue to do so as well.

In addition to FOCUS Reports, various financial and other reports listed in the chart below must also be filed electronically via FINRA's Firm Gateway effective July 1st. TPHs may voluntarily submit these non-FOCUS Report filings via the Firm Gateway in the meantime. (Once you begin submitting financial notifications voluntarily via the FINRA Firm Gateway, you should not revert to prior filing methodologies. The duplicative filings may potentially result in erroneous processing results. In addition, if you have already submitted a filing (e.g., a TPH's Annual Audit) to CBOE, you do <u>not</u> need to re-submit the same filing through the Firm Gateway.)

Please note the chart depicts Firm Gateway availability dates only. Applicable FOCUS Report and other filing deadlines remain unchanged.
