

**Regulatory Circular # RG94-27**

**To:** CBOE Member Firms

**Re:** ILX Rollout

Effective the week of March 21, the CBOE will begin rollout of ILX/WDN PC terminals to booth locations on the trading floor. The terminals will be a replacement for booth-installed Quotron terminals. ILX/WDN terminals will run Windows-based software and will include both an ILX window for market data as well as a CBOE WDN window for CBOE in-house displays and functions. Cost to the firms will be \$350 per terminal per month as filed with the Securities and Exchange Commission made effective April 1, 1994.

ILX features included in this package are as follows:

- Snap and Expanded Quotes with dynamic updates
- Custom Monitor allowing 26 pages of 72 symbols each
- Quote Montage
- Options Montage
- Time and Quotes for stocks and options
- Market and Technical Statistics
- On-line Symbol Book
- Computer-based training
- Alerts and Alert history
- On-line contextual Help function
- CBOE Private News and News Retrieval

CBOE WDN features are as follows:

- CBOE Class Display
- CBOE MDR (time&sales)
- All ORS Booth functions (BERS(XB/XS), IQOD, BK, CXL request, CXL report, Fill reporting)
- Bottom-line Recap
- CBOE Blackboard

Firms will be contacted in the coming weeks so that training and conversion may be scheduled.
