Re: CBOE Trading Floor Dress Code

With the advent of warm weather once again, it becomes necessary to remind members, employees of member firms, and Exchange personnel of the provisions of the CBOE Dress Code (for the complete dress code, please consult an Exchange Rule book or Regulatory Circular #RG92-14). It should be noted that the existing guidelines **prohibit culottes and "skorts"** (a hybrid pant between shorts and skirt) of any material from being worn on the Exchange floor. Note that the guidelines also prohibit sunglasses, shirts without ties, denim jeans, baseball caps, collarless shirts, and tank tops from the trading floor.

The dress code is in effect from the point of entry at all security locations (i.e. turnstiles, 4th floor reception area). As always, member firm personnel are responsible for ensuring that their employees adhere to this policy. Failure to comply with the dress code or other provisions of the trading floor conduct policy **may result in a fine** or denied access to the trading floor.
