Re: Y2K Financial Services Coordination and Communication Center ("FSCCC")

The SIA is preparing for the transition to the year 2000 by coordinating the U. S. Financial Services Coordination and Communication Center ("FSCCC"). The FSCCC will be in operation from about mid-December 1999 through the first week of January 2000. Registered firms in the financial industry will have the benefit of accessing the SIA contingency planning Web site during the active period, in order to receive real-time reports and information from all of the reporting entities--including the exchanges, utilities, payment systems, and others.

REGISTRATION IS REQUIRED

- 1. In order for a firm to reap the benefits of this contingency planning tool, it must register on the SIA contingency planning Web site at www.siay2k.com between 8/16/99 and 11/1/99.
- 2. Upon accessing the Web site registration screen, you will be instructed on how to proceed with your firm's registration.
- 3. As in the Industrywide Test, each firm can register only once, with one primary contact (i.e., "super user" on the web application).
- 4. YOUR FIRM IS ALREADY REGISTERED FOR THE CONTINGENCY PLANNING WEBSITE IF YOUR

FIRM PARTICIPATED IN THE INDUSTRYWIDE TEST, STOCK LOAN TEST, or MARKET DATA
