BATS Exchange, Inc. (the “Exchange” or “BATS”) is filing this amendment to SR-BATS-2012-033 (the “Filing”), which was originally filed on July 27, 2012, to amend text within the Filing in order to reflect a change to the name of the Fund, as defined therein (Securities Exchange Act Release No. 67583 (August 2, 2012), 77 FR 47461 (August 8, 2012)). Specifically, the Exchange proposes to amend the following text in the first sentence of Section 1 on page 3 of 53:

iShares Ultrashort Duration Bond Fund

to:

iShares Short Maturity Bond Fund.

The Exchange also proposes to amend the same text in the title of the subsection starting on page 6 of 53. The Exchange proposes to make the corresponding changes in Exhibit 1 of the Filing, specifically in the title of Exhibit 1 on page 28 of 53, the first sentence of Section I on page 28 of 53, and in the title of the subsection starting at the top of page 32 of 53.

The Exchange also proposes to amend the following text on page 4 of 53 within footnote four:

Registration Statement on Form N-1A for the Trust, dated March 5, 2012

to:

Amendment No. 1 to Registration Statement on Form N-1A for the Trust, dated September 4, 2012.

The Exchange proposes to make the corresponding changes in Exhibit 1 of the Filing, specifically on page 29 of 53 within footnote four.

All other representations in the Filing remain as stated therein and no other changes are being made. As such, the Exchange believes that the Filing, as amended, continues to meet the requirements of Section 6 of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 (the “Act”)¹ along with Section 6(b)(5) of the Act,² because no other changes are being made beyond the Fund changing its name from the iShares Ultrashort Duration Bond Fund to the iShares Short Maturity Bond Fund, and all other representations and statements made in the Filing remain the same.
