



Reminder: BATS BYX Exchange, BZX Exchange and BATS Options NJ2 Certification Environments to be Decommissioned Effective October 31, 2014

Overview

As previously announced, BATS will be relocating its certification environments for the BYX Exchange, BZX Exchange and BATS Options Exchange from the NJ2 data center in Weehawken, NJ to the Equinix NY5 data center in Secaucus, NJ. **The existing certification environments in the NJ2 data center will be decommissioned on Friday, October 31, 2014. Members will be required to utilize the certification environments located in the NY5 data center after this date.**

NY5 certification environments are currently active and available for use by BATS Members.

Physical Ports and Logical Certification Ports

Existing logical certification ports within NJ2 for BYX Exchange, BZX Exchange and BATS Options will not be replicated to the NY5 certification environments. To request physical or logical port access to NY5 certification environments, Members must use the appropriate port request form within the [BATS Member Web Portal](#).
