Update to Auction Response Time Intervals

Effective today, **Friday, October 25**, the Response Time Interval for various auction mechanisms on Cboe Options Exchange, C2 and EDGX Options Exchanges will be updated. For more information on which intervals will be adjusted, see the **Tradedesk Update**.

Transport Layer Security (TLS) Minimum Version Requirement

Quarterly Rebalance of Options Class Tiers Reminder

Cboe Options Exchange rebalances the options class appointment cost tiers every quarter. The rebalancing using third-quarter data takes effect next **Friday**, **November 1**.

Beginning November 1, firms should use the **new appointment weights** when making appointment selections on the Customer Web Portal. Appointment costs are no longer tied to permits and instead will be assessed according to the **Choe Options Fee Schedule**.
