Effective **Thursday, May 2**, Cboe plans to introduce new functionality to the Cboe EDGX Options Exchange to support AON orders, as well as updates to Step-Up-Mechanism (SUM) orders, subject to regulatory review. Testing of the new AON order functionality will be available in the Cboe EDGX Options certification environment effective **Friday, April 5**.

Closing Time Change for Cboe® iBoxx® iShares® Bond Index Futures on Monday

On **Monday, April 1**, Cboe Futures Exchange (CFE) will modify the closing time from 3:15 p.m. to 3:00 p.m. CT for Cboe® iBoxx® iShares® \$ High Yield Corporate Bond Index (IBHY) and Cboe® iBoxx® iShares® \$ Investment Grade Corporate Bond Index (IBIG) futures.
