




PARTIAL AMENDMENT

Chicago Board Options Exchange, Incorporated ("CBOE" or "Exchange") hereby submits this Partial Amendment, constituting Amendment No. 1, to its rule filing SR-CBOE-2007-83 filed on July 17, 2007, in which the Exchange proposes to change the appointment cost for options on the Nasdaq-100 Index Tracking Stock (QQQQ). CBOE notes that it re-evaluated the appointment cost in the QQQQ option class and determined to lower it in order to lower the cost of access to CBOE's marketplace in this option class.
