PARTIAL AMENDMENT

Chicago Board Options Exchange, Incorporated ("CBOE" or "Exchange") hereby submits this Partial Amendment, constituting Amendment No. 1 to its rule filing SR-CBOE-2011-010 relating to Bylaw and related rule changes.

In Item 2 of SR-CBOE-2011-010, CBOE noted that it needed to obtain, but at the time that SR-CBOE-2011-010 was originally submitted to the Commission had not yet obtained, formal approval from its Board of Directors for the specific Bylaw and rule changes set forth in this proposed rule change. CBOE stated that once that approval was obtained, the Exchange would file a technical amendment to this proposed rule change to reflect that approval.

The CBOE Board of Directors approved the specific Bylaw and rule changes set forth in SR-CBOE-2011-010 on February 8, 2011. No further action by the Exchange in connection with this proposed rule change is required.
