Cboe Announces Complex Reserve Orders on C2 Options Exchange

Cboe Europe Receives Authorization to Operate Netherlands Venue

On Monday, Cboe Europe announced that Cboe Europe B.V., its new subsidiary based in Amsterdam, has received authorization from the Dutch Ministry of Finance. Cboe Europe B.V. is now authorized to operate a Regulated Market (RM), Multilateral Trading Facility (MTF) and Approved Publication Arrangement (APA), which will be regulated by the Dutch Authority for the Financial Markets (AFM).

Cboe to Launch Suite of Derivatives-Based Strategy Benchmark and Volatility Indexes Based on MXEF and MXEA

On **Wednesday, March 13**, Cboe announced it had entered into an agreement with MSCI to launch a suite of derivatives-based strategy performance benchmark and volatility indexes based on the MSCI Emerging Markets Index (MXEF) and MSCI EAFE Index (MXEA). BuyWrite, PutWrite and Volatility indexes are being developed for both MXEF and MXEA.
