

Trading Schedule for Presidents' Day Holiday

Changes to Standard Third Friday Expiration Listings for Equity, ETP and Index Options

Beginning **Thursday, April 16**, the Cboe Options Exchanges will list new replacement standard third Friday monthly expirations for Equity, ETP and Index options on the Thursday morning prior to expiration, rather than on the first business morning after. See the [Tradedesk Update](#).

Cboe Elimination of Order Routing Functionality Except from PAR

Effective **Wednesday, April 1**, Cboe Options floor brokers may no longer record the "Represent" times of their orders in Order Entry Devices (such as PULSe and BLAZE terminals). Floor brokers may only record the "Represent" times of their orders with the Represent button on PAR workstations. See the [Tradedesk Update](#).

Percentage Pricing for Non-Index FLEX Orders

On **Tuesday, February 18**, Cboe will add percentage pricing for non-index FLEX orders and auction responses. Percentage pricing indicates that the Strike Price and the Premium are represented in percentage terms of the closing value for the underlying instrument on the trade date.
